Notable Facts

- Named after Zachary Taylor, the 12th. President of the United States.
- The cemetery was established in 1928 by an Act of Congress initiated by the Taylor family to have the government take title to the family burial site.
- The cemetery was listed in the National Registry of Historic Places in 1983.
